De	vice setup  Acquire a device that meets the minimum specifications and accessories. Consider ordering sooner to avoid

	Use <u>Parent Setup quides</u> (see useful information below) to:  O Create an AppleID and Password for the new iPad (if you don't already have one). We encourage you to set this up using Family Sharing. N.B. Students are not required to know their Apple information.  O Ensure your iPad is updated to the latest iPadOS software and check general settings.  O Consider setting up parental controls and content restrictions.  Load the required apps on your child's iPad. This can be done through school licensing using the Intune Company Portal app or via personal purchase via the App Store. Please see the current Apps List for more information, which can be found on
	the school website (see link below).  The school will provide setup assistance sessions at the end of Term 4 and the beginning of Term 1.
Wi	h your child:
	Consider how you will provide your iPad to your child. Is it a family iPad that they will use for school or their own iPad to build their responsibility?  Discuss elements of the NSS BYO iPad information as appropriate (see school website) including responsible behaviour choices and what self-managing with the iPad will look like at school and at home.
	Discuss your child's log in details with them (these will be provided with the iPad documentation in Year 2 and again at the beginning of the school year in Year 3).
	The following information will be provided on a sticker at the start of Year 3 for your child to affix to their iPad.

	The school email, username and password are used to access the school WiFi, the internet (through our filtering system) and Microsoft apps (Intune Company Portal, OneNote, OneDrive, Teams, Word, PowerPoint, Whiteboard)

	Read, discuss with your child, sign and return the <i>Student iPad Responsible Use Agreement</i> , once it is sent home by your Year 3 teacher in Week 1, Term 1.
П	Complete the Online Services Consent Form through OParents, or request a paper copy from the school office
