BYO iPad Program Parent Checklist

Preparing your child to bring an iPad to school.

Device setup

- □ Acquire a device that meets the minimum specifications (see below) and accessories. Consider ordering sooner due to ongoing delivery delays.
 - Option 1 JB HiFi BYOD
 Option 2 Apple Store
 Option 3 Other Provider
- □ Use <u>Parent Setup guides</u> (see useful information below) to:
 - Create an AppleID and Password for the new iPad (if you don't already have one). You may wish to set this up using Family Sharing. **N.B.** Students are not required to know this information.
 - Ensure your iPad is updated to the latest iPadOS software and check general settings.
 - Consider setting up Screen Time and content restrictions.
- □ Load the required apps on your child's iPad. This can be done through school licensing using the Intune Company Portal app or via personal purchase via the App Store. Please see the current *Apps List* for more information, which can be found on the school website (see link below).

With your child:

- Discuss elements of the NSS BYO iPad Handbook as appropriate (see link below).
- □ Ensure that your child understands that **they are not to capture photo**, **video or audio at school unless granted permission to do so** by their teachers.
- Discuss your child's log in details with them (these will be provided with the iPad documentation in Year 2 and again at the beginning of the school year in Year 3).

The following information will be provided on a sticker at the start of Year 3 for your child to affix to their iPad.

The school email, username and password are used to access the school WiFi, the internet (through our filtering system) and Microsoft apps (Intune Company Portal, OneNote, OneDrive, Teams, SharePoint and Word)

At the start of the school year:

- □ Read, discuss with your child, sign and return the *Student iPad Responsible Use Agreement*, once it is sent home by your Year 3 teacher in Week 1, Term 1.
- □ Complete the Online Services Consent Form (online, or request a paper copy)
- □ Ensure the iPad AND case and all accessories are **clearly labelled with your child's name** before sending it in on **Monday Week 2 of Term 1** or as specified by your child's Year 3 teacher.
